

SAT Preparation (Critical Reading and Writing)

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Course Description

Preparing for college entrance? This course can increase students' chances for college admission. Students will review strategies, reading comprehension, grammar, vocabulary, and test-taking techniques by practicing real SAT exams individually and with peers.

This course is designed to prepare students for the SAT by making them familiar with the directions, layout, and test questions, while teaching strategies to improve their knowledge of the tested material and their score on the SAT.
